Councils | Our congregational leadership structure is divided into four councils named after each of our core values: Worship, Community, Missions & Discipleship.

CWC | This stands for Community Wellness Center, our top-quality fitness facility located next door.

Doxology | The doxology is a short hymn of praise. We use it as transition music when children leave the Sanctuary for Kids Worship.

Narthex | The Narthex is the Sanctuary lobby located just outside of the doors at the back of the Sanctuary.

Where can I find...

Bathrooms

There are public restrooms on each floor of the church. Bathrooms with changing tables are on the third floor down from the Fellowship Hall. Restrooms closest to the Sanctuary are near the church office.

Coffee

Free coffee is available on the 1st floor in the adult Sunday School gathering space (outside of the classrooms).

Sunday School Rooms & Childcare

Most adult Sunday School rooms are on the first floor, as is our youth area. Children meet in the Kids' Club on the 3rd floor. The nursery is also in this area. Our elevators have fantastic signage for navigating to these rooms. Don't know which Sunday School class to try? Our greeters would be happy to help you select the best fit.

Emergency Care/First Aid

Greeters and Bible study leaders can help you receive first aid before worship. If you need help during the service, see one of our uniformed officers just outside of the Sanctuary.

Accessibility

Second-Ponce has both ramps and elevators to make our campus more accessible. Any of our greeters, ushers or staff would be happy to help you find/use them.



A few FAQs

How do you pronounce "SPdL?"

SPdL stands for "Second-Ponce de Leon" and its a common nickname for the church used in conversation and written text. We pronounce it "Spee-duhl."

What is in the building next door?

That's the Community Wellness Center, our fitness and recreation facility. It has a pool, indoor walking track, work out equipment, basketball court, personal trainers and more. It is open to the public with competitive rates. Second-Ponce members get an even deeper discount.

What do you have besides worship?

Throughout the week, there are opportunities for children, youth, college students and young adults to meet for fun activities and topical small groups. Singles, seniors and women's fellowships get together each month to hang out and have a great meal. As a church, we go on mission trips and serve our community by pitching in at school fall festivals and hosting city-wide family events.
